The Delhi branch of API has put in a lot of effort to organize this meeting which is the most important event of our association. The whole team under the leadership of respected Dr Yash Pal Munjal, Organizing Chairman has been working hard. Rajesh Upadhyay the organizing secretary, has been ably supported by the vice chairmen Pritam Gupta, RK Singal, Chairman Reception Committee MPS Chawla, Treasurer Anupam Prakash and Joint Secretaries Atul Bhasin, RM Chhabra, Sandeep Garg and Ghan Shyam Pangtey.

The Physician research foundation is an important wing of the API. This conference is historically very important since for the first time we will be having an address from the Director PRF. Also, for the first time we have a one hour 20-minute session under the aegis of PRF on "Research methodologies". This session will be held on 24th Feb in Hall C from 10:00 am to 11:20 am. We have a very distinguished panel including Dr Mark Johnson from Imperial College London, Dr V Mohan from Chennai, Dr Justin Paul and Dr Tiny Nair. They have all got extensive experience in conducting good quality research and then have published them in some of the best medical journals with very high impact factor. We will be having an open discussion on how to develop a correct research question, the correct methodology to be used, ethical clearances that are required, method of registration with the clinical trials registry India, statistical analysis to be done and correct way of scientific writing, so that postgraduate students and young physicians can publish their work. You can start with case reports and retrospective or prospective case series. Then go on to observational registries depending on what problem and disease you want to look at. We will also discuss how randomized trials are conducted and planned and how you can participate in some of these multi centric trials. In case you have any questions or queries regarding this topic, please feel free to write to us so that we can incorporate these in the deliberations. Do visit us in this unique interactive session which is being held for the first time in APICON 2024.

I would like to thank Dr Milind Nadkar the president elect API and Dr. Jyotirmoy Pal the dean ICP for making an excellent scientific program which will be academically enriching for all of us. The infrastructure and venue arranged by the Delhi branch of API is going to be the best that we have ever had for APICONs earlier.

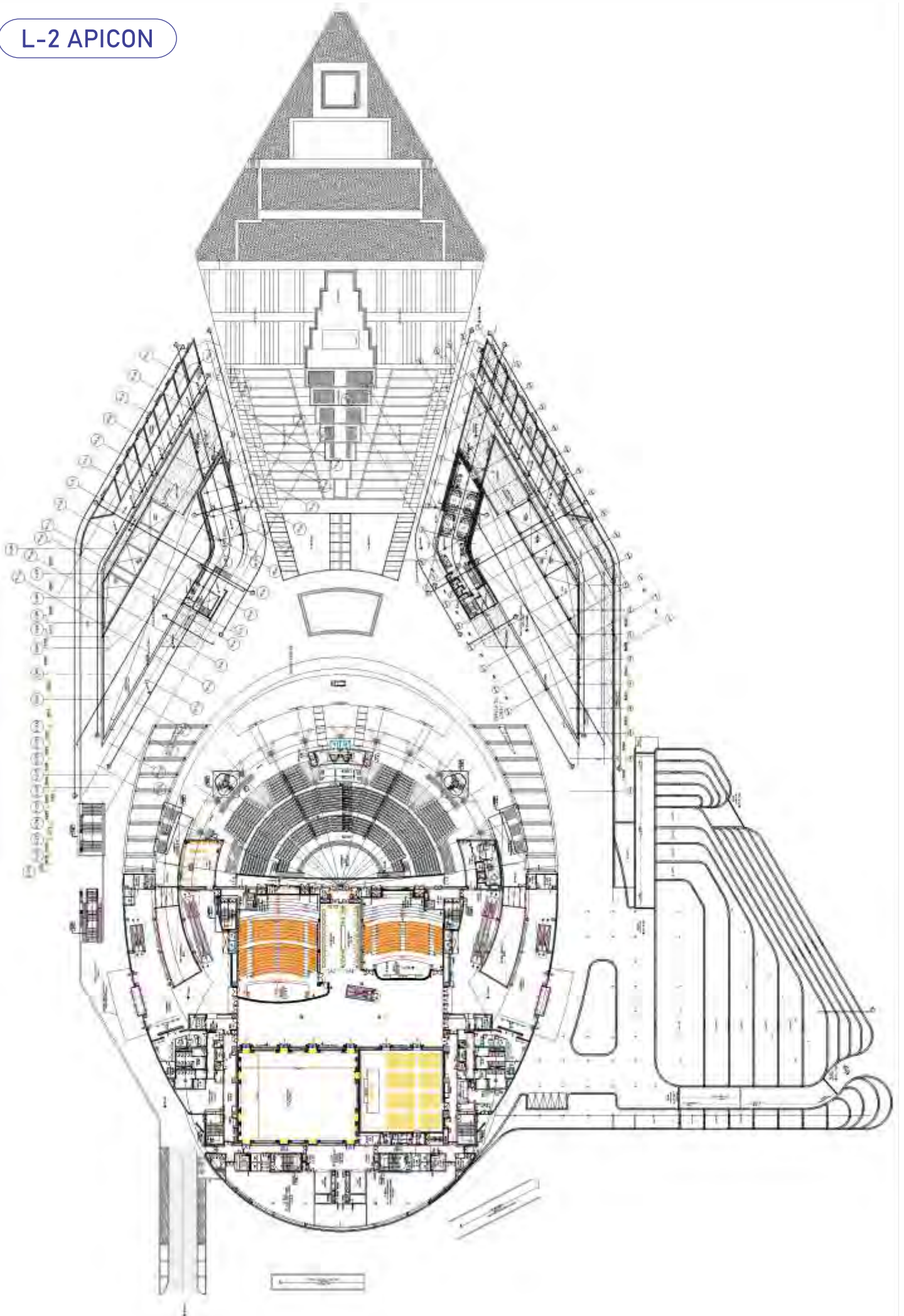
